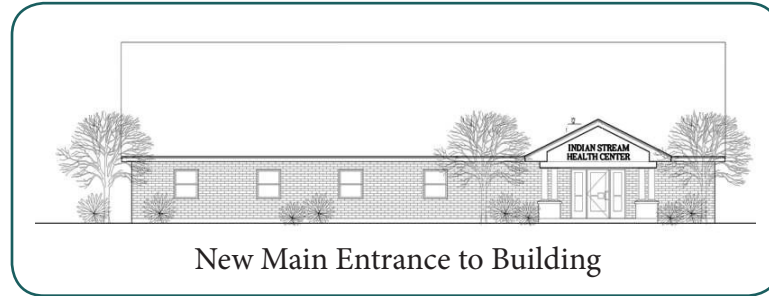

ISHC - A FQHC

Indian Stream Health Center is designated as a non-profit 501(c)(3) Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC).

ISHC's FQHC status allows us to give patients discounts on their care based on household income, and low-cost prescription medications.

GRANT

ISHC receives \$673,548 annually, funds that would not be available to our community if ISHC were a private physician practice.

MODEL

ISHC is a community-based organization. The majority of Board Members are local and patients of ISHC.

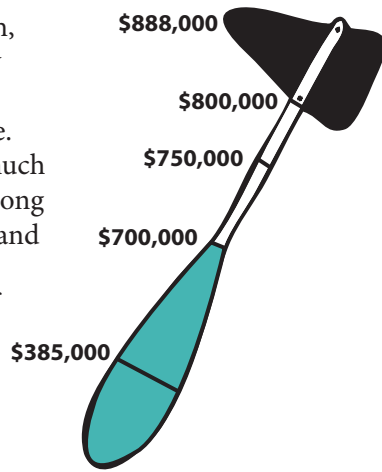

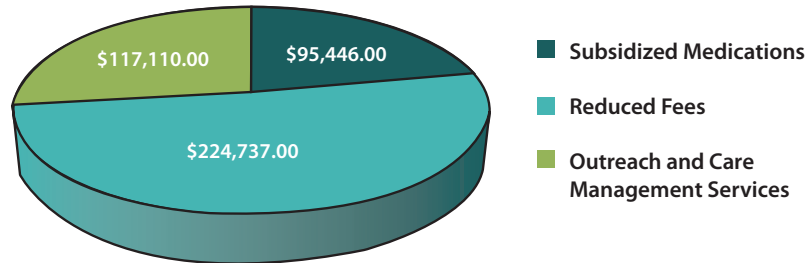
